ASSEMBLY OF TREATY CHIEFS RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION: 01-09-2009#001 R

SUBJECT: SUPPORT FOR RUN FOR HUMAN RIGHTS II

WHEREAS the Chiefs of the Treaty No. 6, Treaty No. 7, Treaty No. 8 [Alberta] hereinafter known as the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs did meet at a duly convened Fall Sitting held at the Radisson South, in Edmonton, Alberta on September 1st, 2nd and 3rd, 2009; and

WHEREAS Chief Terrance Nelson of Roseau River Anishinabe First Nation in Manitoba, made a presentation to the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs regarding the Run for Human Rights II taking place on September 3rd, 2009 from Winnipeg, Manitoba to Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS Chief Terrance Nelson explained the purpose of the run is to inform the United States of America government and its citizens of issues related to Resource Development, Environment and Health that First Nations are dealing with in Canada; and

WHEREAS Chief Nelson invited the Alberta Treaty Chiefs to participate as runners and/or provide political support for the Run for Human Rights II.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs fully supports the Run for Human Rights II and that the First Nations prepare strong messages from the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs to the government and people of the United States of America; and

FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED that Chief Wayne Moonias will take the political lead to ensure the following steps are fulfilled:

- * This resolution is forwarded to Chief Terrance Nelson of the Roseau River First Nation by September 2, 2009; and
- * To ensure that the First Nations in Alberta receive this resolution by September 2, 2009.
