ASSEMBLY OF TREATY CHIEFS RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION: 02-09-2009/#002 R

SUBJECT: REAFFIRMATION OF THE REJECTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF ALBERTA'S FIRST NATIONS POLICY ON LAND MANAGEMENT AND RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS the Chiefs of the Treaty No. 6, Treaty No. 7, Treaty No. 8 [Alberta] hereinafter known as the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs did meet at a duly convened Fall Sitting held at the Radisson Hotel South, in Edmonton, Alberta on September 1st, 2nd and 3rd, 2009; and

WHEREAS the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs recognize that their respective technicians met on July 29th, 30th and 31st, 2009 at the Edmonton Marriot, River Cree and Casino Resort, to address the Government of Alberta's Consultation Policy on Land Management and Resource Development (2005); and

WHEREAS the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs at a previous AoTC rejected the Government of Alberta's First Nations Consultation Policy on Land Management and Resource Development as per Resolution: 14-09-06/#003R;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs reaffirm their previous position rejecting the Government of Alberta's First Nations Consultation Policy on Land Management and Resource Development; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Grand Chiefs from Treaty No. 6, Treaty No. 7 and Treaty No. 8 and their appointed technicians develop an Action Plan, which may include Consultation Principles, as a formal response to Consultation; and

FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED that draft Action Plan and Consultation Principles be presented to all First Nations Chief and Council within 30 days for consideration and feedback.
