ASSEMBLY OF TREATY CHIEFS RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION: 30-03-2010#09(B)R

SUBJECT: Community Corrections Program 2010-2011

WHEREAS the Chiefs of Treaty No. 6, Treaty No. 7, Treaty No. 8 (Alberta) known as the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs did meet in a duly convened assembly held March 29, 30, and 31 in Treaty No. 7 Traditional Territory at the Coast Plaza Conference Centre in the City of Calgary, Alberta; and

WHEREAS Minister Oberle has met with the Tsuu T'ina and Stoney Corrections Society, Yellowhead Corrections Society, the Kainai Community Corrections AND Siksika Nation Corrections where he did inform the decision to continue operations of the Community Corrections Program for the 2010-2011 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS Minister Oberle has informed the Kainai Community Corrections Society that the Kainai Community Correctional Centre will continue to operate for the next two months during which time negotiations between staff of his department and representatives of the Society will take place to explore future options for the Correctional Centre; and

WHEREAS Minister Oberle acknowledged our partnership as a Government to Government and Nation to Nation Relationship and has committed to fully consult with the First Nations involved on next steps and future development of First Nation programming.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs of Treaty No. 6, Treaty No. 7 and Treaty No. 8 hereby forward a letter to Minister Oberle acknowledging the commitment to engage in discussions during the 2010-2011
