## ASSEMBLY OF TREATY CHIEFS RESOLUTION

**RESOLUTION:** 30-03-2010#11R

**SUBJECT:** SUPPORT FOR THE BIGSTONE CREE NATION'S PROPOSAL TO INDIAN AND NORTHERN AFFAIRS CANADA (INAC) FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MULTIPLEX FOR REPATRIATION AND THE HEALING FROM THE NEGATIVE IMPACTS OF RESIDENTIAL SCHOOLS

**WHEREAS** the Chiefs of Treaty No. 6, Treaty No. 7, Treaty No. 8 (Alberta) known as the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs did meet in a duly convened assembly held March 29, 30, and 31 in Treaty No. 7 Traditional Territory at the Coast Plaza Conference Centre in the City of Calgary, Alberta; and

**WHEREAS** the long term negative impacts of Residential Schools in First Nations communities is insurmountable which requires a deliberate and strategic approach to overcome; and

**WHEREAS** the Bigstone Cree First Nation is attempting to deal with the Residential School impacts in a strategic way and has submitted a proposal to Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) requesting the establishment of multiplex for repatriation and the healing from the negative impacts of residential schools.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** that

1. the Assembly of Treaty Chiefs hereby fully support the Bigstone Cree First Nation in its proposal submission and call on the Government of Canada to seriously consider and fund the proposal; and

2. the concept of a multiplex for repatriation and healing be considered a pilot project so that First Nations in Alberta can follow suit.
